Notices will be sent by Certificate of Mailing. There will be at least 30 days between mailing of follow-up notices so violations can be cured during that time period. Any resident can request a hearing to dispute a violation. Damages will be cumulative. Liens will be filed periodically and will include not only the damages, but the cost of filing and removing the liens.

Please note that certain conduct may also be a violation of municipal ordinances. For instance, the parking of a boat or trailer for a period greater than 14 days is also prohibited by Middleton Township.

Restrictions on the installation of fences, hedges and similar violations, or the failure to submit landscaping or building plans, shall not apply if the violation(s) occurred prior to September, 2011. The HOA, however, may require that these violations be resolved at the time the property is sold.
